AIR POLLUTION MONITORING EQUIPMENT SPECIALIST

Employee will also be responsible for routine field collection of air pollution monitoring data and samples. Successful candidate must have electronic instrumentation experience or training. Job duties include climbing ladders, lifting and handling of delicate equipment and working outside.
