RAPCA Hosting Diesel Emission Reduction Grant Program Workshop

The Regional Air Pollution Control Agency will be hosting an Ohio Diesel Emission Reduction Grant (DERG) Program workshop on **Tuesday, November 1, 2011 from 10am – Noon.**

Ohio EPA, which recently announced the new DERG program, is expected to award up to \$10 million in Federal Highway Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding for clean diesel projects in 2012 and another \$10 million in 2013.

Representatives from Ohio EPA will be on hand to discuss program details and answer questions for interested applicants and equipment vendors.

The DERG program aims to achieve measurable highway emissions reductions; improve air quality and public health; and encourage the transportation sector to clean up diesel fleets and use alternative and cleaner burning fuels.
