AN INFORMAL RESOLUTION

Supporting and Endorsing the Continued Use
of Electric Trolleys by the Greater Dayton
Regional Transit Authority.

WHEREAS, The City of Dayton is unique among most of the nation's cities in that its public transportation system has a combination of electric and diesel powered buses; and

WHEREAS, Electric trolleys have a history and record of being environmentally friendly, as they do not emit hydrocarbons into the atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, Electric trolleys are almost silent, not adding to the noise pollution caused by diesel or gasoline engines; and

WHEREAS, the electric trolley is the backbone of the public transportation system within the City of Dayton, contributing to our quality of life by providing a public transportation system that is both clean and quiet; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTON:


Section 1. The City of Dayton City Commission recommends that the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority explore the option of increasing the use of electric trolleys, promoting the efficiency and economic feasibility of the entire system.

Section 2. The City of Dayton urges the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority to maintain electric trolleys as an integral component of the public transportation system in the City of Dayton where it is efficient and economically feasible.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Commission is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Informal Resolution to the members of the Board and Executive Director of the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority.




