AIR QUALITY AWARENESS WEEK

RAPCA is Working with Local Retailers to Promote Battery Powered Lawn Mowers

As part of this year's Air Quality Awareness Week, which runs from May 3rd to May 7th, RAPCA will be working with three local lawn equipment retailers to promote the use of battery powered mowers.

Beginning Thursday, May 6th, anyone who purchases a pollution-free, WORX WG780 19" battery-powered mower at one of three local retailers will be eligible to receive a **free** WORX WG151 battery-powered trimmer **or** a WORX WG540.5 battery powered blower, **while supplies last**. Each store will have a minimum of 10 blowers and 10 trimmers.
